

## Auckland in Profile

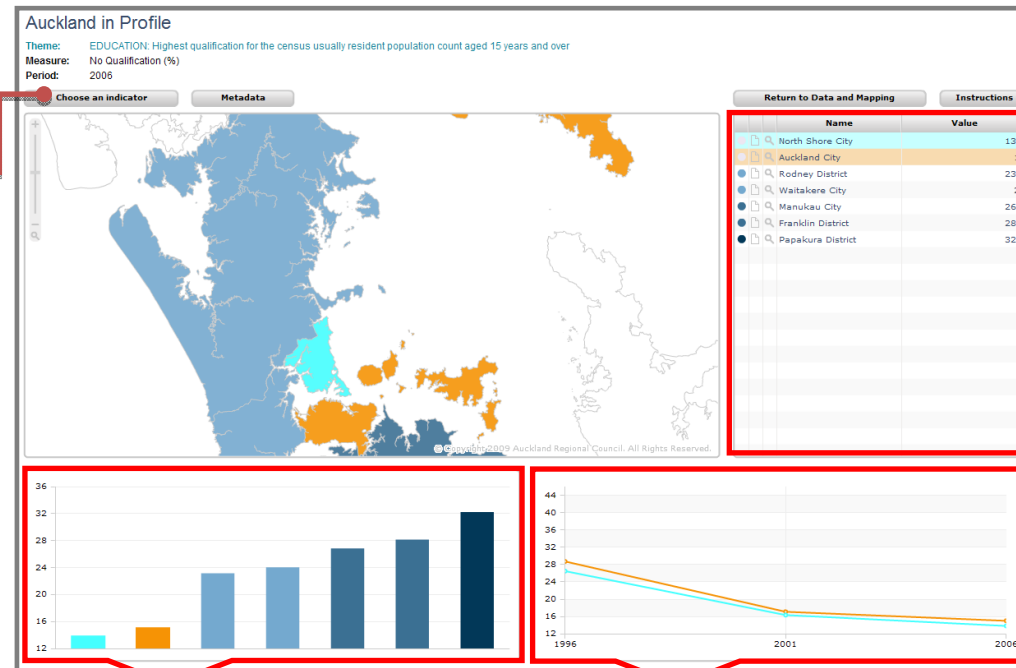
The Auckland in Profile tool is available under the 'Data and Mapping' section of Knowledge Auckland. The tool allows you to compare indicators across the seven territorial authorities of Auckland. Indicators can be selected from the drop down list, by clicking on the **'choose an indicator'** button. Indicators are broken down into **measures** then **periods**. Once you select your desired measure and period, the map will automatically populate the data.

EDUCATION: Highest qualification for the census usually resident population count aged 15 years and over

- ▶ INCOME: Median annual personal income for the employed census usually resident population aged 15 years and over
- ▶ POPULATION: Age for the census usually resident population
- ▶ POPULATION: Ethnic group (Level 1 grouped total responses) for the census

**Measure** is the category and/or unit in which the indicator is available. For example 'No Qualification %' is the percentage of the usually resident population with no qualifications.

**Period** is the interval the indicator is available in, and is most commonly a census period, such as 2001 or 2006.



### Table:

The table shows each territorial authority alongside their actual value in descending order. For example in the 2006; 13.8 per cent of the usually resident population in North Shore City had no qualification.

Colours assigned in the table correspond with the map, bar chart and time series. Colours range from; light grey which is the lowest value to dark blue, the highest value.

Actual values in the table are shown as per their **measure**. In this case per cent (%)

### Additional functions

It is possible to print the information on screen by right clicking anywhere on the map and selecting 'print preview' then selecting the 'print' button.

Information can also be exported as a picture file by right clicking anywhere on the map and selecting 'export', then selecting the desired file output and pressing 'export'.

### Bar chart:

The chart automatically populates upon selecting an indicator, in which each territorial authority is graphed ascending from the lowest value to the highest, left to right. This provides a point of comparison between each authority

### Time series:

When available, the time series will graph the indicator showing changes from previous periods. Most commonly, indicators are graphed against the two previous census periods. The time series will automatically populate upon highlighting a territorial authority in the table.

System Requirements: Adobe Flash Player is required to view Auckland in Profile. Adobe Flash Player is available from <http://get.adobe.com/flashplayer>

It is possible to compare two authorities in the time series graph by *clicking* one and *hovering over* with the mouse pointer on the second desired authority.
